Tie-Break :-

Eligibility :- participants registered with AICF & MCA residing in Maharashtra State are eligible for Maharashtra State Selection Chess Tournament. The players have to bring original and Xerox copy of birth certificate along with two recent copies of photographs.

MCA & AICF Player Registration :- If not register with MCA for the year 2016-17 then every participant has to pay Rs. 150/- as registration fee of Maharashtra Chess Association else show the original receipt and submit one Xerox copy along with completed entry form. If not register with AICF for the year 2016-17 then every participant has to pay Rs. 250/- as registration fee of All India Chess Federation else show the original receipt and submit one Xerox copy along with completed entry form.

Entry Fee :- Rs. 200/-

(Entry fee along with entry form once paid will not be refund)

Note :- Eligibility, AICF & MCA Registration and Entry fee paid along with completed entry important note from AICF.

PIO (Person of Indian Origin) / iOC (Oversease Citizen of India) card holders :

As per Government of India guidelines / rules, players with PIO/OCI documents cannot play for India. As a result, AICF had taken a decision that these players cannot participate in any selection tournaments like district selection / State selection and National Championship which ultimately lead to the selection of the Indian National team. However these players can play in all FIDE rated events and other tournaments in India and abroad.

If they wish to participate in all FIDE official events like the World Youth Championship or Continental Youth Championship it is necessary that they have to register as member of the Country of which they are citizens. In case they decide to register with the Country of their citizenship, the AICF will issue a No Objection Certificate on their request.

However, to enable these players to participate in other tournaments in India, they can register with AICF, with conditions as stated above. A Separate registration form for PIO/OCI is enclosed for your ready reference. The same can be downloaded from AICF website.

It is therefore requested that all state chess associations to inform all tournament organizers under their jurisdiction to collect the appropriate player's registration from for PIO/OCI players before submitting to AICF.

Other Rules :

1. For this Tournament latest FIDE Rules will be applicable and pairing will be done based on latest Swiss pairing rules.
2. Before start of first round other rules, if any, will be announced and displayed at tournament venue.
3. Spectators (including players who have finished their games, parents, managers and coaches) should stay away from playing area during the rounds especially age category. As per latest FIDE rules spectators has to obey or use the allowed area for viewing games.
4. General discipline should be maintained at tournament venue and lodging place.
5. Appeal committee will be formed amongst participats/parents or promient chess players (For age category especially U7 to U19 please see that committee member is at least 18 years or more with good knowledge of chess). In case of any disputes against the Arbiter's decision, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 500/- within 30 minutes oif the occurence of the incidence. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
6. Players are compulsory to present for the opening and closing ceremony of tournament.
7. Interpretation :- For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not coivered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the tournament committee, comprising organizer, chief Arbiter and one of the MCA officials shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament committee, comprising organizer, chief Arbiter and one of the MCA officials shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. However, such changes will be displayed in the tournament venue.
8. Rights of Admission :- The organizer reserve the right to admit or refuse any entry without assigning any reason thereof. They also reserve the rights of admission to the venue and lodging place.
