**1. Schedule:** 9<sup>th</sup> September to 13<sup>th</sup> September 2015

**2. Arrival:** Arrival at tournament hall on 9<sup>th</sup> September at 8:00 AM; Registration at 9:00 AM; Inauguration at 10:00 AM ; Players Meeting After Inauguration ; First round will start at 11:00AM; Prize Distribution on 13<sup>th</sup> September at 1:30PM .

**3. Eligibility:** Player Residing in Maharashtra, born on or after 01-01-1990 can participate in tournament. Date of birth proof is must. Please attach Xerox copy of birth Certificate, along with Entry form. As per FIDE Guidelines, player participating in FIDE Rating Tournament must have a valid e-mail id.

**Age Proof:** Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his/her age.

**Certificates from School are not valid.** Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without date of birth certificates will not be allowed to participate.

**\*\* The date of birth certificates registered within one year of the birth of the child alone will be recognized and allowed to participate. No district association shall recommend any player who doesn't come under the above criteria. Any player who is aggrieved by this stipulation can appeal to AICF with proper documentary proof and the AICF's decision in this regard will be FINAL and BINDING.**

**4. System of Play:**

The Championship shall be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess. The time control for each game shall be 90 minutes and additional increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one. Total round would be depend on no. of players.

**5. Prize Fund :**

A total of 10 prizes in Cash amounting to Rs. 40,000/- (Rs. Forty Thousand Only) + 30 trophies. Special age category trophies shall be awarded as under:

Prizes shall not be shared and a player would be eligible for one higher prize only. Participation Certificate would be issued to all the players. Prizes shall be forfeited if the recipient of the prize is not present in the PD function. Players must be present for the closing ceremony of Championship.

## 6. Entry Fee:

Rs. 500 - District selected player/seeded players

(Selected Dist. Chess players must bring letter from their respective District Association)

Rs. 1,000 - Donor category entries.

### Mode of Payment:

### Submission and Last Date of Entries :

- The payment is to be forwarded along with the entry form and copy of birth certificate duly completed in all respects latest by 5th September, 2015 at the address Mr. Sandip Salunke (cell : 8149881781) 26, Datta Colony, Korit Road, Nandurbar- 425412.
- Thereafter Payment shall attract late fee of Rs.200/-. The entries with late fee will be accepted till 7.00 pm on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2015. Please make a note that entry once paid will not be refunded.

### AICF/MCA Registration of Players for the year 2015-2016:

All the participants must be registered with AICF for the year 2015-2016. Those who have paid the AICF Registration fee but are yet to receive the AICF Registration card should send a photo copy of the acknowledgment for having paid the fee to organizers of earlier tournaments or to their association. Those who have not registered with AICF for the year 2015-16 should send an amount of Rs.250/- towards AICF registration fee along with the duly filled and signed AICF player's registration form plus one passport size photo. Application forms are available in the website: [www.aicf.in](http://www.aicf.in) In addition, required to obtain MCA Registration for the year 2015-2016 by sending an amount of Rs.150/- towards MCA registration fee along with the duly filled and signed MCA player's registration form plus one passport size photograph. This formality should be completed before the end of Round 4 or else, a penalty of Rs.100/- would be charged. ## 7. Lodging:

Free dormitory type lodging will be provided to the selected/seeded players from the each participating District, subject to condition on submission of their entries on the letter head of District Association. Accommodation will be provided from 09-09-2015 to 13-09-2015 till 5pm. Accompanying persons would be provided accommodation @ Rs.100/- per head per day (Rs.500/-).

**8. Time Control :** 90 minutes + 30 second increment from 1st move. Walkover Time – 30 minutes.

## 9. Article 6.6: Default Time:

Any player who arrives at the chessboard 30-minutes after the start of the session shall lose the game. Thus the default time is 30-minutes."

### **10. Selection for National U-25 Chess Championship 2015:**

The top four players from this event shall be eligible to represent Maharashtra in the National Under-25 Chess Championship 2015 to be held in Patna ( Bihar).

### **11. Tie Break:**

Buchholz shall be applied to resolve the tie. However, the prizes would not be shared.

### **12. Protests:**

Protests, if any against the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 500/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The amount shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

### **13. Appeals Committee:**

Five members Committee of Appeals shall be formed. The decisions of the Appeals Committee would be final and binding on all the participants.

**14. Information to Selected Players for Nationals :** Those who are selected in this event has to give confirmation to chief Arbiter, before tournament venue. Due to some circumstances , selected player dose not participate in National Tournament and it makes MCA unable to give chance to the next selected player,hence it is decided that selected player should inform the same at least 7days

before the National Tournament, otherwise he/she has to pay penalty of Rs.5,000/- to MCA. If 11 hour cancellation is there because of some unavoidable conditions, i.e. (health problem of player,death of near relatives )then various documentary evidence will be required like medical certificate , letter from school etc including recommendation from district secretary to avoid penalty.

**15. Reimbursement Claim :** The reimbursement is for Selected players from State selection Chess tournament of 2015, and seeded players. Selected players from Maharashtra State Selection Chess tournament, has to confirm about his/her participation in National Tournament, by filling confirmation form .After declaration of National Chess tournament dates and circular, selected players have to pay, Entry fee, as mentioned in circular, to MCA ,at least two days before the last date of depositing entry fee,as mentioned circular of National Chess Championship.

No entry fee will be accepted with late fee in the case of selected players.MCA will intimate and confirm your nominations to the organiser. After completion of National tournament, player has to submit the reimbursement form along with original receipt and Xerox copy of national participation certificate,with in one month of commencementof tournament.**Praposal submitted after one month, will not be consider for reimbursement and it will be treated as cancelled.**MCA will issue the cheque of reimbursement amount or will be deposited in your Bank Account.

**Right of Admission:** Organizer reserves right to admit or refuse any entry, without assigning any reason and at stage of the tournament. They also reserve the right of admission to the venue.
