2. Eligibility:

The participants shall not have FIDE Title or a published FIDE Rating of <u>1700</u> or <u>2000</u> or <u>2300</u> or more at the start of the Championship (1st October 2016), nor had such a rating for at least 12 months prior to the start of the Championship (1st October 2015). All players registered with Maharashtra State Association are eligible to participate in the State Amateur Championship. Only Indian Nationals are eligible to participate in the Championship.

3. System of Play / Rounds & Time Control:

The Championship shall be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess. The time control for each game shall be 90 minutes and additional increment of 30 seconds per move starting from moves one. Total number of rounds is nine.

5. Entry Fee:

Rs. 500/- (For Selected Players must bring letter from their respective District Association) & Rs.1000/- (For Donor Player) to be paid on or before 20th September 2016, by cash or by D.D. only. There After a Late Fee of Rs. 200 /- will be charged up to 2nd October 2016 at 5.00 pm.

NO SPOT ENTRY. Please draw the Demand Draft from Nationalize Bank only in favor of Nagpur Chess Academy, Payable at Nagpur.

On cancellation of entry, fees will be refunded.

No request towards the waiver of late fee will be accepted.

6. AICF/MCA Registration of Players for the year 2016-2017:

All the participants must be registered with AICF for the year 2016-2017. Those who have paid the AICF Registration fee but are yet to receive the AICF Registration card should send a photo copy of the acknowledgment for having paid the fee to organizers of earlier tournaments or to their association.

Those who have not registered with AICF for the year 2016-17 should send an amount of Rs.250/- towards AICF registration fee along with the duly filled and signed AICF player's registration form plus one passport size photo. Application forms are available in the website: www.aicf.in .In addition, required to obtain MCA Registration for the year 2016-2017 by sending an amount of Rs.150/- towards MCA registration fee along with the duly filled and signed MCA player's registration form plus one passport size Application forms are available in the website: photograph. www.maharashtrachess.com. This formality should be completed before the end of Round 4 or else, a penalty of Rs. 100/- would be charged.

7. Accommodation:

Players have to make their own arrangement for their stay during the event. If informed well in advance Hotel Accommodation may be booked. For the same, payment to be made in advance by sending DD / NEFT in favor of Nagpur Chess Academy payable at Nagpur.

8. Selection for National:

First four players from each category of below rating 1700, 2000 and 2300, are eligible to represent Maharashtra in National Amateur Chess Championship 2016 at Mumbai, as per AICF present regulation.

9. Tie Break:

In the case of tie Prize money will not be shared. Tie Break as per latest FIDE laws will be applicable.

10. Protests:

Protests, if any against the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 500/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The amount shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

11. Appeals Committee:

Five members Committee of Appeals shall be formed. The decisions of the Appeals Committee would be final and binding on all the participants.

12. Information for the Selected Players for Nationals:

Those who are selected in this event have to give confirmation to Chief Arbiter, at the tournament venue. Due to some circumstances, selected player dose not participate in National Tournament and it makes MCA unable to give chance to the next selected player.

Hence it is decided that selected player should inform the same at least 7 days before the last date of entry of the National Tournament as per Circular, otherwise he/she has to pay penalty of Rs. 5,000/- to MCA.

If 11th hour cancellation is there because of some unavoidable conditions, i.e. (Health problem of player, mishap to near ones) then various documentary evidence will be required like medical certificate, letter from school etc. including recommendation from district secretary to avoid penalty.

13. Reimbursement Claim:

The reimbursement is for selected players from State selection Chess tournament of 2016 and seeded players. Selected players from Maharashtra State Selection Chess tournament, has to confirm about his/her participation in National Tournament, by filling confirmation form. After declaration of National Chess tournament dates and circular, selected players have to pay, Entry fee, as mentioned in circular, to the Organizer, at least two days before the last date of depositing entry fee, as mentioned in circular of National Chess Championship. No entry fee will be accepted with late fee in the case of selected players. MCA will intimate and confirm your nominations to the organizer. After completion of National tournament, player has to submit the reimbursement form along with original receipt and Xerox copy of National participation certificate, within one month of commencement of tournament. Proposal submitted after one month, will not be consider for reimbursement and it will be treated as cancelled. MCA will issue the cheque of reimbursement or amount will be deposited in your Bank Account.

14. Rules & Regulations:

- 1. Tournament will be conducted as per FIDE and AICF rules.
- 2. Other rules will be displayed on Notice Board at Venue.
- 3. Spectators (Players who have finished their Games, Parents, Managers & Coaches) should stay away from playing area during the rounds.
- 4. General discipline should be maintained at Tournament venue and Lodging place.
- 5. Chief Arbiter decision shall be final and binding to all.
- 6. Players shall cooperate with the organizers of tournament, in all matters and strictly abide by the rules and regulations of Tournament.
- 7. Players shall be present for the Opening & closing ceremony of Championship.
- **8. Rights of Admission:** The organizers reserve the right to admit or refuse any entry without assigning any reason thereof. They also reserve the rights of admission to the venue.
- **9. Interpretation:** For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the tournament committee comprising organizer, chief arbiter and one of the MCA / NCA official shall be final and binding on all. The tournament committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. Such changes however displayed in the tournament hall.
