Invitation:

Mumbai Suburban District Chess Association, under the auspices of Maharashtra Chess Association have the honour to invite players from all the MCA affiliated District Chess Associations from Maharashtra to participate in the Maharashtra State Under-25 FIDE Rating Chess Championship 2016 to be held at Ram Mandir Charitable Trust Hall Opp Ismail Yusuf Bus Stop (towards Andheri) Janata Colony Jogeshwari East Mumbai- 400060 from 14th August to 18th August 2016 (both days inclusive).

Eligibility:

Players Born on or after 1-1-1991 are eligible to participate in this tournament. Players are required to submit a copy of their Birth Date Certificate along with Entry form.

System of Play:

The Championship shall be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess for a total of nine rounds. The time control for each game shall be 90 minutes for the entire game plus and additional increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.

Prizes:

A total of 10 prizes in Cash amounting to Rs. 40,000/- (Rs. Forty Thousand Only) + 24 trophies for the special age-category prizes shall be awarded as under:

Age shall be reckoned as on 01st January 2016.

Trophies to 3-Best Players: Under-09, 11, 13 & 15 categories, separately for Boys & Girls.

These special prizes shall be awarded only within the age-groups.

For Example: a player under-9 shall not be eligible for U-11 prize and so on.

Prizes shall not be shared and a player would be eligible for one higher prize only.

Participation Certificate would be issued to all the players.

Prizes shall be forfeited if the recipient of the prize is not present in the PD function.

Players must be present for the closing ceremony of championship.

Selection for National U-25 Chess Championship 2016:

The top four players from this event shall be eligible to represent Maharashtra in the National Under-25 Chess Championship 2016 to be held in September 2016

Article 6.6: Default Time:

Any player who arrives at the chessboard 30-minutes after the start of the session shall lose the game. Thus the default time is 30-minutes."

Tie Break:

Buchholz shall be applied to resolve the tie. However, the prizes would not be shared.

Lodging:

Free dormitory type lodging will be provided the selected players from affiliated Districts of Maharashtra Chess Association. (provided they had their selection trials). Accommodation will be provided from 14th August to 19th August 2016 till 10 am. Accompanying persons would be provided accommodation @ Rs.3000/- for all days

Protests:

Protests, if any against the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.500/- **within 30 minutes** of the occurrence of the incident. The amount shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Appeals Committee:

A seven member Committee of Appeals (inclusive of 2-reserves) shall be formed from amongst players/officials/coaches present on the Inaugural day. The decisions of the Appeals Committee would be final and binding on all the participants.

Interpretation:

For interpretation of the Rule(s) and for deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the tournament committee shall be final and binding on all. The tournament committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. Such changes shall, however, be displayed in the tournament hall.

AICF/MCA Registration of players for the year 2016-2017:

All the participants must be registered with AICF for the year 2016-2017. Those who have paid the AICF Registration fee but are yet to receive the AICF Registration card should send a photo copy of the acknowledgment for having paid the fee to organizers of earlier tournaments or to their association. Those who have not registered with AICF for the year 2016-17 should send a amount of Rs.250/- towards AICF registration fee along with the duly filled and signed AICF player's registration form plus one passport size photo. Application forms are available in the website: www.aicf.in.

In addition, required to obtain MCA Registration for the year 2016-2017 by sending an amount of Rs.150/- towards MCA registration fee along with the duly filled and signed MCA player's registration form plus one passport size photograph.
