INVITATION :

Mumbai Suburban District Chess Association under the auspices of Maharashtra Chess Association have the honour to invite players from all District Chess Associations from Maharashtra to participate in the Maharashtra State Under-11 FIDE Rating Chess Championship 2016 to be held at **Nikunj Hall, R.N. Sheth Vidya Mandir, Near Amboli railway crossing phatak, Andheri East Mumbai**, from 11th May to 13th May 2016 (both days inclusive).

Tournament Schedule :

Eligibility:

Players Born on or after 1-1-2005 are eligible to participate in this tournament. Players are required to submit a copy of their Birth Date Certificate along with Entry form.

System of Play :

The Championship shall be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess. The time control for each game shall be 60 minutes and additional increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one. Total round would be depend on no. of players.

Prizes :

A total of 10 prizes in Cash amounting to Rs. 20,000/- (Rs. Twenty Thousand Only) + trophies.

Prizes shall not be shared. Participation Certificate would be issued to all the players. Prizes shall be forfeited if the recipient of the prize is not present in the PD function. Players must be present for the closing ceremony of championship.

Selection for National U-11 Chess Championship 2016:

The top two players from this event shall be eligible to represent Maharashtra in the National Under-11 Chess Championship 2016.

Article 6.6: Default Time:

Any player who arrives at the chessboard 30-minutes after the start of the session shall lose the game. Thus the default time is 30-minutes."

Article 9.1: The Drawn Game

The rules of a competition specify that players cannot draw the game by mutual agreement before **30** moves without the consent of the Arbiter.

Tie Break:

Buchholz shall be applied to resolve the tie. However, the prizes would not be shared.

Lodging:

Free dormitory type lodging will be provided to the selected players from each of the participating District Accommodation will be provided from 10/05/2016 to 12/05/2016 Accompanying persons would be provided accommodation @ Rs.500/- per head per day

Protests:

Protests, if any against the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.500/- **within 30 minutes** of the occurrence of the incident. The amount shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Appeals Committee :

Five members Committee of Appeals shall be formed. The decisions of the Appeals Committee would be final and binding on all the participants.

Entry fee & Payment Mode:

The entry fee for participation in this event is Rs. 500/- (Rs. Five Hundred Only) per player,(for official District Entry, For others it is Rs. 1000) which is payable by Cheque/DD/Bank Transfer favouring **Mumbai Suburban District Chess Association**.
