Invitation:

Mumbai Suburban District Chess Association, under the auspices of Maharashtra Chess Association have the honour to invite players from all the MCA affiliated District Chess Associations from Maharashtra to participate in the Maharashtra State Under-25 FIDE Rating Chess Championship 2014 to be held at Thakur College of Science & Commerce (Ground Floor, Stilt Premises), Thakur Village, Kandivali (East), Mumbai - 400101 from 01st to 05th October, 2014 (both days inclusive).

Eligibility:

Players Born on or after 1-1-1989 are eligible to participate in this tournament. Players are required to submit a copy of their Birth Date Certificate along with Entry form.

System of Play:

The Championship shall be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess for a total of nine rounds. The time control for each game shall be 90 minutes for the entire game plus and additional increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.

Prizes:

A total of 10 prizes in Cash amounting to Rs. 40,000/- (Rs. Forty Thousand Only) + 24 trophies for the special age-category prizes shall be awarded as under:

Age shall be reckoned as on 01st January 2014.

Trophies to 3-Best Players: Under-09, 11, 13 & 15 categories, separately for Boys & Girls.

These special prizes shall be awarded only within the age-groups.

For Example: a player under-9 shall not be eligible for U-11 prize and so on.

Prizes shall not be shared and a player would be eligible for one higher prize only.

Participation Certificate would be issued to all the players.

Prizes shall be forfeited if the recipient of the prize is not present in the PD function.

Players must be present for the closing ceremony of championship.

Selection for National U-25 Chess Championship 2014:

The top four players from this event shall be eligible to represent Maharashtra in the National Under-25 Chess Championship 2014 to be held at Tamil Nadu.

Article 6.6: Default Time:

Any player who arrives at the chessboard 30-minutes after the start of the session shall lose the game. Thus the default time is 30-minutes."

Article 9.1: The Drawn Game

The rules of a competition specify that players cannot draw the game by mutual agreement before **30** moves without the consent of the Arbiter.

Tie Break:

Buchholz shall be applied to resolve the tie. However, the prizes would not be shared.

Lodging:

Free dormitory type lodging will be provided to the two selected players from each of the participating District (provided they have conducted their selection trials). Accommodation will be provided from 01/10/2014 to 06/10/2014 till 10 am. Accompanying persons would be provided accommodation @ Rs.750/- per head, per day (Rs.3750/- for 5-nights).

Protests:

Protests, if any against the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.500/- **within 30 minutes** of the occurrence of the incident. The amount shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Appeals Committee:

A seven member Committee of Appeals (inclusive of 2-reserves) shall be formed from amongst players/officials/coaches present on the Inaugural day. The decisions of the Appeals Committee would be final and binding on all the participants.

Interpretation:

For interpretation of the Rule(s) and for deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the tournament committee shall be final and binding on all. The tournament committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. Such changes shall, however, be displayed in the tournament hall.

Entry fee, Mode of Payment, Last Date & Submission of Entries:

The entry fee for participation in this event is Rs. 500/- (Rs. Five Hundred Only), which is payable by Cash or Demand Draft favouring **Mumbai Suburban District Chess Association**, Payable at Mumbai. The payment is to be forwarded along with the entry form duly completed in all respects latest by 25th September, 2014 at the following

address. Payment thereafter shall attract late fee of Rs.100/- Please make a note that entry once paid will not be refunded. The organizers reserve the right to admit or refuse any entry without assigning any reason thereof. They also reserve the rights of admission to the venue.

AICF/MCA Registration of players for the year 2014-2015:

All the participants must be registered with AICF for the year 2014-2015. Those who have paid the AICF Registration fee but are yet to receive the AICF Registration card should send a photo copy of the acknowledgment for having paid the fee to organizers of earlier tournaments or to their association. Those who have not registered with AICF for the year 2014-15 should send a amount of Rs.250/- towards AICF registration fee along with the duly filled and signed AICF player's registration form plus one passport size photo. Application forms are available in the website: www.aicf.in.

In addition, required to obtain MCA Registration for the year 2014-2015 by sending an amount of Rs.150/- towards MCA registration fee along with the duly filled and signed MCA player's registration form plus one passport size photograph.
